

- **We are changing/updating High School Fair and Open House information daily; if you do not see your school listed here, parents should check the individual High School web site for updates.**

- Mt. St. Michael has changed the date for Open House. Wednesday Information sessions (virtual) Oct. 7, 14 and 21 at 7:00 PM. Interested families will participate via Google Meets.

Open House Saturday, Oct 24 from 12 to 3. Pre-registration required. Rain Date Sunday, Oct. 25 from 12 to 3. (Most of the activities will be outside)

- Due to COVID-19 concerns, the Manhattan High School Fair at Cathedral HS has been cancelled. They may schedule virtual fairs at a later time. Check the Open House link updated fair details as they become available.
- Due to COVID-19 concerns, the High Schools in the Bronx have made the decision to cancel their Fall 2020 fairs. They may schedule virtual fairs at a later time. Check the Open House link updated fair details as they become available.
- Diocese of Brooklyn/Queens Fairs at St Francis College on 9/23 and St John's University on 9/28, have been cancelled.
- Parents should check the individual High School web site for updates on Open Houses.
- **Prior to registration**, Review online remote testing system and device requirements and understand and be able to consent to the use of Proctorio; the Artificial Intelligence system that will monitor and record your student's test session.
- Register for the exam via internet or telephone; register before the deadline on October 23, 2020, at 5:00 PM EST. **No late registration or walk-in students will be allowed this year.**
- **When registration is completed, you will receive an email.** Read the email thoroughly for other important information and "next steps".
- **After** you register, (you will require your assigned TACHS ID) but prior to 5:00 PM EST on November 5, 2020, enter your High School choices on [tachsinfo.com](http://tachsinfo.com). Your choices may be edited up until November 5. Failure to complete this information prior to November 5, will result in scores being unavailable to your High School choices.
- On October 31, 2020, you will receive an email with your test session code/date/time of testing along with helpful tips and guides that will ensure successful testing. You will not be able to start your test session on the day/time of testing without this information, Students will test on the day assigned to their aligned diocese. There will be (3) different start times. Students will be randomly assigned to start times, and no time preference can be accepted.
